1. Intro

- 1. How do we handle the difficult times that surround us?
- 2. Thesis
 - 1. Are we willing to pay the price for God's sake?
- 3. Recount the dream in Chp 2.
 - 1. Nebuchadnezzar thought of himself as somebody, especially after the interpretation of his dream by Daniel. (pride 2:32-33)
 - 2. As a result he built this statue

2. The Problem

- 1. Everyone was to bow down before the king. (5-6)
 - 1. Idolatry in these men's eyes (12) (Ex 20:4-5)
 - 2. Even when these men were trained to function in this new culture, they never took their eyes from God.
- 2. We face decisions every day. Little to big.
 - 1. Would like others to make decisions for us.
- 3. When we have to make decisions do we:
 - 1. Put them in a balance scale?
 - 1. How do we stay out of the fire?
 - 1. God won't mind if we just do this one time.
 - 2. We will go through this even if it cost us.

3. Paying the Price

- 1. Problems can't be solved if we ignore them.
 - 1. Shadrach, Meshach and Abednigo's problem was not going to go away by ignoring it (14)
 - 1. Why do some problems stay with us.
- 2. We want deliverance without disturbance
 - 1. Deliver us from this fire without us having to commit to you.
- 3. We want success without sacrifice
 - 1. You gave us positions of authority, why this testing?
 - 1. Out testing will refine us.
- 4. We need to shift our priorities.
 - 1. Shadrach, Meshach and Abendigo's eyes never came off of their priority. To serve God
 - 2. Our culture is one of consumerism; which focuses in on our comfort and well being (supposedly). (Advertising campaigns)
 - 1. We will take care of your needs.
 - 2. We will keep you comfortable.

4. Price Paid

1. Never get comfortable

- 1. Daniel and these men lived in a different culture, but never conformed to it.
- 2. Never allow for plan B. (in commitment)
 - 1. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednigo in the fire. Nothing could be done to them, they had no plan B (16-18)
 - 2. Don't have on a maintenance mind set. (Don't settle for lest than best)
 - 1. Maintenance mind set is the easy way out.
 - 1. I am quite satisfied where I am.
- 3. We were never promised to be spared from the fire.
- 4. But God will be there to take us through the fire.

5. Conclusion

- 1. We are to seek Him
 - 1. We should seek righteousness, not happiness (Matt 6:33)
- 2. Look to Christ is our problem solver (Matt 11:28-30)
 - 1. Just as Shadrach, Meshach and Abednigo did.
- 3. We may have to go through the fire
 - 1. That fire will purify us to serve Him in a greater way.
